

Wake Forest ARTS call for artists!

100 under \$100



December 2-18, 2011

The opening of this exhibition coincides with the Lighting of Wake Forest and the downtown Wake Forest Holiday Open House. Artwork will be on exhibit Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays only.

All work should be priced under \$100. No theme or media restrictions. Work must not exceed 32" in any dimension. ***This is a juried exhibition.***

Submission deadline.....Monday, November 14
Notification of acceptance..... Tuesday, November 22
Artwork drop off Thursday, December 1, from 11am-4pm
Opening nightFriday, December 2, from 6-9pm
Artwork pick-up.....December 18, from 5-6 pm

Replacement request: All artwork sold during this exhibition will be removed from the exhibition. If this occurs you may be contacted by WFA to submit another piece to take the place of the purchased work of art. WFA is unable to store artwork in the loaned exhibition space; therefore, works not picked up by artwork pick-up deadline will become property of WFA.

Entry fees: Payable upon delivery of artwork. Entry fees are non-refundable.

The show is open to two- and three-dimensional works of art. Work must be authentic, original and completed in the last 2 years. **No copies, mechanical reproductions, molds or kit work will be accepted.** All work cannot exceed 32" in any dimension (including frame). Two-dimensional work cannot weigh more than 30 lbs. WFA reserves the right to exclude work due to size or special requirements. All two-dimensional work must be dry, wired and ready to hang. No clip frames or alligator hangers. Photographs and matted works on paper should be single matted with a white or similar neutral mat. **Entries must be hand delivered to 206 S. White Street, in downtown Wake Forest.** Artwork submitted on behalf of an artist requires written and signed authorization from the artist.

Sales: WFA will retain a commission of 20% on all work sold during the exhibit. Artists are strongly encouraged to participate at the exhibit. Buyer information may be released at the discretion of the buyer and may not be available to the artist.

Eligibility: 100 under \$100 is open to all living artists. A maximum of 5 works of any medium per artist may be submitted. All works must be original and completed within 2 years of the entry deadline.

Liability: All entries will be handled with the best care possible, but WFA is not responsible for loss or damage do to any cause. WFA is not responsible for any insurance deductible. By entering into this show, the artist agrees to abide by all rules and regulations as set by exhibition guidelines.

Submission procedure:

Digital **images of your artwork** should be emailed, along with your **full name, mailing address** and **phone number(s)** to WFA at exhibits@wakeforestarts.org

- Submit digital images of at least two of your works in JPEG format. One image is acceptable for each two-dimensional work; three images for each three-dimensional work.
- File size cannot exceed 4MB. The minimum image size cannot be lower than 500px.
- Images must be oriented correctly.
- Acceptance to the exhibition will be based on digital images of your artwork.
- Notification of acceptance gives WFA permission to use submitted images for promotional purposes.
